Allan Lyell Vickery 25/06/1939 - 05/01/2016

the loss of Traralgon Farmers Market member of Yallourn North Lions stalwart Allan Vickery, who passed away on the 5th January 2016, after suffering a long illness.

Whilst Allan did not initiate our market, he quickly recognised that the market in its early days, could be run better. Consequently, Allan approached stallholders and Latrobe City with the idea that the Lions Club of Traralgon assume management of the market. With a vote of confidence from the stallholders and a Business Plan in place, Latrobe City granted market management to the Lions Club.

Allan's theory was that stall fees would be far better placed in the community, than in a private operator's pocket. Allan also offered a management style that provided stallholders with regular advertising, a consultative approach and regular communication. Allan was selective with stallholders and not backward in sacking anyone not up to the required standards. Allan is responsible for the great market that we enjoy today.

Traralgon Farmers Market was but one facet of Allan's community activities. Allan was a Councillor at Narracan Shire (now within Baw Baw Shire) at the age of 29 years. Allan was also a Scoutmaster at Yallourn North. Allan was also involved with the Walhalla Development League. This was while Allan lived at Yallourn Allan also made a significant North.

In 1980 Allan moved to Traralgon and transferred to the local Lions Club. It would be fair to say that the Traralgon community benefitted from Allan's relocation. Allan was a driving force in Traralgon for the establishment of the Victory Park Soundshell, playground equipment in cooking for everyone. Allan leaves Newman Park, the establishment of a Spinal Cord Fellowship within Lions, Carols by Candlelight, Australia Day Breakfast and the senior Citizen's Christmas Party.

Allan was formally recognised for his contribution to the community with the Latrobe City 2013 Citizen of the Year Award.

positions and was a long time Director and Fund Raising Manager within Traralgon Lions Club. However, beyond his home club, Allan's Lions career scaled the lofty heights of Lions hierarchy, becoming Multiple District 201 Chairman in 1985/86. This position is responsible for all Australian Lions Clubs, plus Papua New Guinea, Norfolk Island and East Timor. There are many Lions serving today who have sought Allan's wise counsel when decisions needed to be made. Allan made many friends within Lions and this was evidenced by the large Lions contingent in attendance at his funeral.

Above all, Allan was a family man. Allan was particularly fond of family gatherings and looked forward to behind his wife of fifty four years Maree, sons Dale and Grant, daughter Sally and a large extended family.

The respect with which Allan was held by Traralgon Farmers Market Stallholders was evidenced at his funeral, with several in attendance, some with significant distances travelled.

Allan's legacy to our market is an ever popular market with sound management, a good selection of stallholders and a progressive outlook for the future.
