LATROBE CREATIVE PRECINCT

As some of you may have noticed, work has started on our new 'Creative Precinct'. Scheduled for completion in 2020 the new facility will occupy ground to the north and east of the library/service centre and will include:

- A 750 seat theatre within a new performing arts centre;
- A multi-purpose Studio (a smaller, versatile space that can be configured into a variety of performance modes);
- Multipurpose/Meeting rooms;
- An indoor/outdoor café; and Outdoor event spaces.

Construction will tale at least 12 months and there may be some disruption to our market. Hopefully it will be minor and the end result will be of great benefit to our community and our market space. Stay tuned for developments.
